

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF SOME PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

PROGRAM	TYPE	DETAILS
Residential Opportunities	Visitation at Group Homes	Suspended visitation to IRAs in Erie County during the Orange designation.
	Medical Appointments	Only necessary medical appointments are occurring in Erie County. Visits have transitioned back to telehealth wherever possible.
	Person Served Return to Group Home	Persons served are not being prohibited from returning to the IRAs. We have asked families not to take their loved one home during this time but we are not preventing their return. We will quarantine those who return in their bedroom, to the best extent possible.
	Community Outings	Community Outings have been sharply curtailed in Erie County.
Health Center	General Operations	The Aspire Health Center will remain open full time Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., with on call services available outside of regular business hours. We will be evaluating upcoming schedules for medical, podiatry & therapy visits on a routine basis. As appropriate, we may be rescheduling routine visits or converting in-person visits to virtual/telemedicine visits, in an effort to minimize the risk of COVID exposure for the patients we support.
Day-Hab-Certified 7 Community Dr. Brock Tech Tonawanda Hamburg Mall Blvd	General Operations	All Erie County Day Hab Certified Programs have been closed until further notice. Day Services Staff are providing day programming to individuals that we support that live in Aspire IRA's. We have begun providing "community in home" day services on a limited basis. Mall Blvd in Chautauqua County remains open.
Day Hab- Without Walls SVLE- Erie County CO-OP Tech Buffalo SVLE-Chautauqua North County SVLE- Chautauqua Jamestown	General Operations	SVLE – Erie County, Co-Op, and Tech Buffalo are all open, however are operating under a reduced capacity and through some virtual services. SVLE Northern Chautauqua County and Jamestown are operating at full capacity.
CILS	General Operations	The following programs continue to be provided in person: Self Directed Services, Community Habilitation, In Home respite, Free-Standing Respite, and Vocational Services.

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SDS	General Operations	No changes have been made to general operations. Service/supports continue to be provided in person. Tele-health continues to be a viable back up support if needed. Services are being adjusted to best meet individual needs.
Respite	General Operations	Free Standing respite and in-Home Respite continue to operate. Saturday site-based respite has been suspended in Erie County because of colored zones. After School respite has not restarted and will be evaluated for restart when schools reopen.
Community Habilitation	General Operations	Community Habilitation services/supports continue in person. Operations continue to be flexible to meet the changing needs of community environments impacted by COVID restrictions. Telehealth continues to be an option available if needed.
Vocational Services	General Operations	No changes have been made to general operations. Operations are flexible to meet the changing Community COVID Support needs. Services have remote option as needed. Services are being adjusted in response to individual needs and changes in community business environments impacted by COVID requirements.
CFL School Age Pre-school	General Operations	Students at the CFL and all off-site locations in the preschool and school age programs are receiving instruction and teletherapy via a hybrid model (both in-person and virtually). Community based services and evaluations are operating on a hybrid model as well.
Student Transition		All student transition services have switched to 100% remote services.
Children's Discovery Corner		The day care remains open. Parents have increased the number of days their children are in attendance now that school districts are closed for in-person services. Staff assist children with their remote learning activities.
