# Halloween Excitement

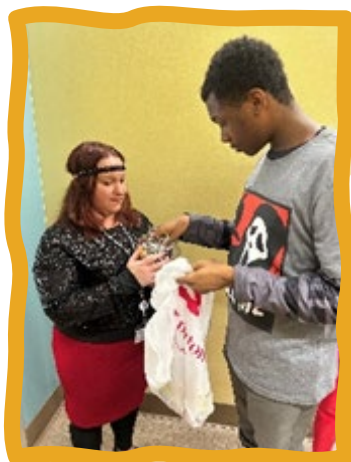


Halloween was full of magic and excitement at the Center for Learning!

We're so *grateful* for a day full of laughter, imagination, and memories to carry us all the way to next year's spooky celebrations!

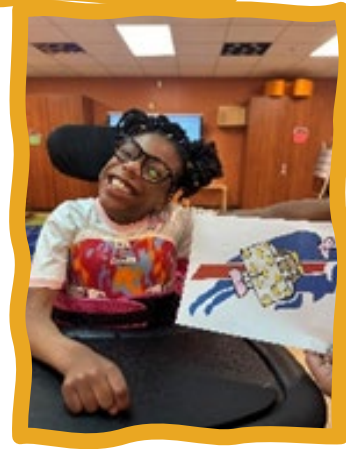
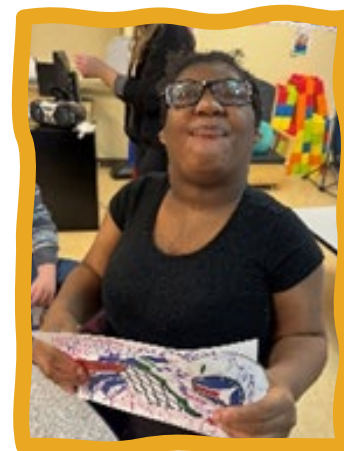
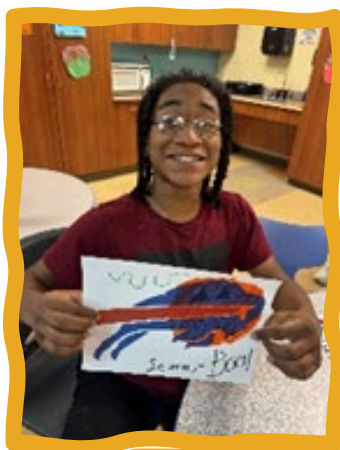
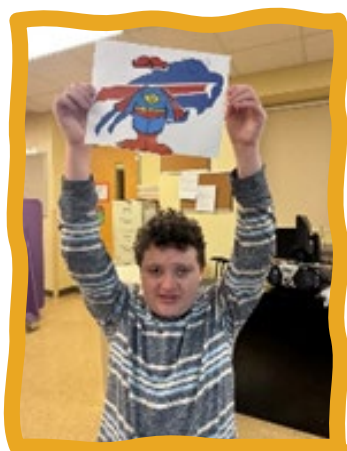


# Halloween Excitement Continued....
